

# Caring for your Rubber Chucky

## Please Read!

Here are some tips for taking care of your Rubber Chucky.

First and foremost like most of us they **DON'T LIKE EXTREME HEAT** or **COLD**.

**If you turn in a non climate controlled environment do not store your Rubber Chuckies in Heat above 100°F or below 40°F**

High Humidity is also hard on them.

If it is too hot or cold for you it is for them as well.

Any of these conditions could cause them to crack or otherwise become unusable.

Like any tool – to ensure their longevity – take care of them!

You can hit them with a hammer (not recommended but we have done so in testing) and it won't hurt them but they don't like extreme temperatures or humidity.

It is OK to use them in the above conditions (but who turns in those conditions anyhow), just don't leave them exposed other than while turning.

To clean them you can wipe them down with Denatured Alcohol and then give them a Light Coat of WD-40. Do not saturate them – just wipe them down. Allow to completely dry before using.
